COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 64, L.D. 116, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Real Estate Brokerage Laws"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the next to the last line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "members" the following: 'the members' spouses, parents and children'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 9 and before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 10. Effective date. Section 2 of this Act takes effect for each public member upon completion of the term of the person who is the current public member.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in an insignificant increase in dedicated revenues to the Maine Real Estate Commission by allowing nonresident real estate licensees to place their licenses on inactive basis.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill changes the definition of public members from "having had" no professional real estate connection to "having no such connection." This amendment extends this prohibition to the spouses, parents and children of the public member.
