24	of each year. These signs must be removed by November 1st of each year and must be erected on private property with

28	signs. The signs must conform to standard department requirements for official business directional signs.
30	Notwithstanding section 1911, subsection 2, if a farmer erects signs under this paragraph, the farmer may not be

36	STATEMENT OF FACT
38	This amendment allows signs on private property only, not on certain highway rights-of-way. The amendment also limits the
40	number of signs to 2 and requires that the signs meet the Department of Transportation requirements for official business
42	directional signs. The amendment also limits the number of official business directional signs that may be used by farmers
44	who use the 2 signs authorized in this amendment.
