HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 86,
L.D. 121, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the
Travel Information Advisory Council Concerning Informational
Signs"

Amend the amendment in "Sec. 2." in paragraph F in the first
blocked paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 13
and 14 in amendment) by striking out the following: "primarily
selling their own produce" and inserting in its place the
following: 'selling only their own fresh fruit, berries and
vegetables'

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under this amendment, the farmers who sell only their own
fresh fruit, berries and vegetables are permitted to erect signs.
