HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 86, L.D. 121, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Travel Information Advisory Council Concerning Informational Signs"

Amend the amendment on page 1 by striking out all of the last paragraph (lines 42 and 43 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 (page 2, lines 1 to 15 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'23 MRSA §1926 is enacted to read:

§1926. Agricultural advertising signs

The commissioner shall adopt rules to govern the erection, maintenance and removal of signs for advertising agricultural produce including fresh fruit, berry and vegetable crops. The rules adopted by the commissioner must also include eligibility requirements and types, arrangements, number and locations of agricultural advertising signs. The color of these signs must be green, or if official business directional signs are green, then a color that distinguishes agricultural advertising signs from official business directional signs.

The commissioner shall ensure that signs erected pursuant to this section may be in place by July 1, 1991.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph from the end before the statement of fact (page 2, line 17 in amendment).

This amendment requires the Commissioner of Transportation to adopt rules governing the erection and maintenance of agricultural advertising signs.
