SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 86,
L.D. 121, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the
Travel Information Advisory Council Concerning Informational
Signs"

Amend the amendment by striking out all 7th to 11th
paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
its place the following:

·23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶D-1 is enacted to read:

D-1. Signs appended to a farmer's own official business
directional sign to advertise that farmer's fresh fruit,
berry and vegetable crops in season from June 15th to
November 1st of each year. These temporary seasonal signs
may not exceed the dimensions of and may be removable from
the existing official business directional sign. The farmer
may choose the color, lettering and graphics of the
temporary seasonal signs and may attach and remove the
appended section of the sign to advertise the current
availability of the farmer's crops.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.' '

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment permits farmers to add signs advertising the
availability of their produce to their own official business
directional signs.
