Signs appended to a farmer's own official business directional sign to advertise that farmer's fresh fruit, 28 berry and vegetable crops in season from June 15th to November 1st of each year. These temporary seasonal signs 30 may not exceed the dimensions of and may be removable from the existing official business directional sign. The farmer 32 may choose the color, lettering and graphics of the temporary seasonal signs and may attach and remove the 34 appended section of the sign to advertise the current availability of the farmer's crops. 36 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 38 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
