An Act to Prohibit the Sales and Service of Propeller Spurs.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 12 MRSA §6434, 1st ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c.
428, is amended to read:

6 No A person may not raise, lift, transfer, possess or in any
8 manner molest any lobster trap, warp, buoy or car except as
provided in this section. A person may not sell, install or
10 repair an automatic line-cutting device on the propeller shaft of
any vessel.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill prohibits the sale or service of automatic
line-cutting devices, commonly referred to as spurs.
