An Act Concerning Liquor Pricing.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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28-A MRSA §455, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Under rules adopted by the commission pursuant to section 452, an agency liquor store may increase the purchase price of any item that is by rule deemed to require refrigeration and that contains 18% or less of alcohol by volume.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows an agency liquor store to increase the purchase price of certain items requiring refrigeration pursuant to rules of the State Liquor Commission.
