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**An Act to Regulate Further Ozone-depleting Products.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

38 MRSA §1608 is enacted to read:

§1608. Ozone-depleting products

7 After January 1, 1992, no person may sell or offer for sale  
8 in this State the following ozone-depleting products:

10 1. Cleaning sprays. CFC cleaning sprays for noncommercial  
11 or nonindustrial usage in cleaning electronic and photographic  
12 equipment;

14 2. Fire extinguishers. Hand-held halon fire extinguishers  
15 for residential use; and

16 3. Party streamers and noisemakers. Party streamers and  
18 noisemakers in aerosol containers that contain CFC.

20 For purposes of this section, "CFC" has the same meaning as  
21 in section 1606.

26 This bill prohibits the sale of certain products that  
27 contain chlorofluorocarbons after January 1, 1992.
