HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 91,  
L.D. 132, Bill, "An Act Concerning Purchases of Alcohol from  
Agency Stores"

Amend the amendment in subsection 1-A in paragraph D in the  
3rd line (page 2, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the  
following: "deliver," and inserting in its place the following:  
'deliver to the commission or the state liquor store,' and by  
adding at the end (page 2, line 25 in amendment) the following:  
'The commission or the state liquor store must pay the amount  
added to the retail sales price pursuant to paragraph C to the  
Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the process by which an agency  
store selling spirits to a restaurant must report the sales and  
turn over the State's share of the sale proceeds.
