2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §606, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1987, c. 342,
4	§28, is further amended to read:
6	1. All licensees must buy liquor from commission; exception. Except as provided in paragraph-A this subsection and
8	<u>subsection 1-A</u> , all persons licensed to sell spirits shall purchase all such liquor from state liquor stores. Agency liquor
10	stores may not sell liquor to retail licensees for resale.
12	A. This subsection does not apply to public service corporations operating interstate.
14	Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §606, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

	1-A. Exception. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a restaurant
18	<u>located at least 15 miles from a state liquor store may purchase</u> <u>spirits from an agency liquor store and agency liquor stores may</u>

24	STATEMENT OF FACT
26	This bill provides an exception to the general rule that a person licensed to sell spirits must purchase the liquor from
28	state liquor stores and agency stores may not sell liquor for resale. The bill permits a restaurant located 15 or more miles
30	from a state liquor store to purchase spirits from an agency store.
