HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 98,
L.D. 139, Bill, "An Act to Exempt the Repair and Maintenance of
Road Culverts from Approval by the Department of Environmental
Protection"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph A by striking
out all of subparagraph (3) (page 1, lines 45 and 46 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(3) Not longer than 75 feet.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph A by
striking out all of subparagraph (3) (page 2, lines 23 and 24 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(3) Not longer than 75 feet.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 2-A
by striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, lines 47 and 48 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'C. Not longer than 75 feet.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reflects recent changes adopted by the Board
of Environmental Protection regulating culverts under the natural
resources protection laws.
