Ancillary culverting activities, including excavation and 2 filling, are included in this exemption. subsection shall ensure that erosion control measures are taken to prevent sedimentation of the water and that the crossing does not block fish passage in the water course.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in an annual reduction in dedicated revenue to the Maine Environmental Protection Fund in an estimated amount of between \$750 to \$1050 depending upon the number of projects impacted.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This amendment replaces the original bill. The amendment changes the title of bill and clarifies the intent of the original bill to exempt the repair, maintenance and replacement of existing road culverts from permitting by the Maine Land Use 20 Regulation Commission and the Department of Environmental Protection under the natural resource protection laws and the 22 shoreland zoning laws. Culvert construction standards not related to permitting are not affected by this amendment.

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
