STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Exempt the Repair and Maintenance of Road Culverts from Approval by the Department of Environmental Protection.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §438-A, sub-§5, as affected by PL 1989, c. 890, Pt. A, §40 and amended by Pt. B, §46, is further amended to read:

Any areas within a municipality that are 5. Exemptions. subject to nonmunicipal zoning and land use controls may be 8 exempted from the-operation-of this section upon a finding by the 10 commissioner that the purposes of this chapter have been accomplished by nonmunicipal measures. The replacement, maintenance or minor repair of any road culvert is exempt from 12 this section.

Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §480-Q, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, c. 430, 16 §6, is further amended to read:

2. Maintenance and repair. Maintenance and minor repair of structures in fragile mountain areas, or to structures above the high water line causing no additional intrusion of an existing structure into the great pond, river, stream or brook, wetland or sand dune; and maintenance and repair of private crossings of a river, stream or brook; and replacement, maintenance or minor
24 repair of any road culvert, provided that:

26 A. Erosion control measures are taken to prevent sedimentation of the water;

B. The crossing does not block fish passage in the water 30 course; and

32 C. There is no additional intrusion into the river, stream or brook.

Sec. 3. 38 MRSA §488, first ¶, as amended by PL 1977, c. 374, 36 §4, is further amended to read:

38 This Article shall does not apply to any development in existence of , any development in possession of applicable state 40 local licenses to operate ⊖≆<u>, any development</u> under or construction on January 1, 1970, Θr --to any development the 42 construction and operation of which has been specifically authorized by the Legislature prior to May 9, 1970, or to public service corporation transmission lines, except transmission lines 44 carrying 100 kilovolts or more, nor shall does it apply to the renewal or revision of leases of parcels of land upon which a 46 structure or structures have been located as of March 15, 1972, ner to the rebuilding or reconstruction of natural gas pipelines 48 or transmission lines within the same right-of-way, or to the replacement, maintenance or minor repair of any road culvert. 50

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts the replacement, maintenance and minor repair of road culverts from permits required under the natural 6 resource protection laws, the site location of development laws and the mandatory shoreland zoning laws.
