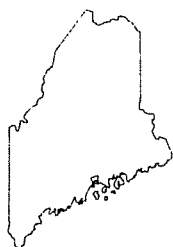

An Act to Preserve the Integrity of the Maine State Lottery.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

8 MRSA §389 is enacted to read:

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§389. Operation of lottery

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With the exception of lottery sales agents licensed to sell
lottery tickets or shares, state employees are the only agents
authorized to conduct operations of the state lotteries.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill maintains the integrity of the lottery system by
ensuring only persons directly accountable to the State may be
authorized to be involved in the conduct of operation of the
lotteries.

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
