An Act to Regulate Petitioners at the Polls on Election Day.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21-A MRSA §682, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

6 4. Petitioners prohibited. A person may not present a
8 petition for signatures on election day within 100 feet of the
10 entrance to any polling place.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that persons seeking petition signatures on election day be located at least 100 feet from the polling place.
