16	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place
18	the following:
20	' 12 MRSA §6671, sub-§9, as amended by PL 1985, c. 737, Pt. A, §29, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
22	9. Penalty. Notwithstanding Title 17-A, section 4-B, a
24	person who takes or possesses shellfish in violation of a municipal ordinance adopted under this section commits a crime
26	<u>punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than</u> <u>\$1,000, except that:</u>
28	A. For taking shellfish from a closed area or for digging
30	shellfish without a license, the fine may not be less than \$500 and not more \$1,500; and
32	B. A fine for a violation of article 5 must be as provided
34	by section 6681.'

38	STATEMENT OF FACT
40	This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment establishes fines of \$500 to \$1,500 for digging shellfish in a closed area or
42	digging shellfish without a license and fines of \$100 to \$1,000 for violations of any other municipal shellfish conservation
44	ordinances.
