IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Increase the Death Benefits under the Workers' Compensation Act.



Be it	enacted	by	the	People.	of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:
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2 39 MRSA §59, as amended by PL 1989, c. 897, is further amended to read:

§59. Burial expenses; incidental compensation

If the employee dies as a result of the injury, the employer shall pay, in addition to any compensation and medical benefits provided for in this Act, the reasonable expenses of burial, not to exceed \$4,000 \$10,000 and an additional payment of \$3,000 \$5,000 as incidental compensation. Burial expense reimbursement must be paid to the person who has paid or who is responsible for paying the employee's burial expenses. The incidental compensation must be paid to the employee's estate.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the burial expense and incidental compensation benefits provided under the Workers' Compensation Act.
