COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 127, L.D. 172, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Family Unity"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other \$15,738

Provides funds for the printing and distribution costs of a wage and labor laws poster.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1992-93

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$15,738

This bill requires a one-time General Fund appropriation to the Department of Labor of \$15,738 in fiscal year 1992-93 for the printing and distribution of the minimum wage poster. If additional bills are enacted that also require a change to this wage poster, then the cost properly allocated to this bill can be reduced.'
