HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 90,  
L.D. 175, Bill, "An Act Related to the Office of Substance Abuse"

Amend the amendment in section 7 in subsection 6 by  
inserting at the end the following:

'Any new contract must be awarded through a request-for-proposal  
procedure and any contract of \$100,000 per year or more that is  
renewed must be awarded through a request-for-proposal procedure  
at least every 6 years.'

The director shall establish a procedure to obtain assistance and  
advice from consumers of alcohol and other drug abuse services  
regarding the selection of contractors when requests for  
proposals are issued.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that any new contracts entered into  
and certain contracts renewed by the Office of Substance Abuse  
must be awarded through a request-for-proposal procedure. The  
amendment also requires the Director of the Office of Substance  
Abuse to establish a procedure to obtain assistance and advice  
from consumers of alcohol and other drug abuse services regarding  
the selection of contractors.
