34	This amendment requires that any new contracts entered into and certain contracts renewed by the Office of Substance Abuse
36	must be awarded through a request-for-proposal procedure. The amendment also requires the Director of the Office of Substance Abuse to establish a procedure to obtain assistance and advice
38	from consumers of alcohol and other drug abuse services regarding the selection of contractors.
