the General Fund as a result of this bill are \$27,821 in fiscal 2 year 1991-92 and \$54,723 in fiscal year 1992-93.

4 These estimates may require adjustment depending on the current services budget enacted by the Legislature. The 6 Governor's proposed adjusted current services budget affects these programs and these estimates.

The costs associated with public hearings, providing or 10 assisting in the provision of training programs, overseeing, supporting and coordinating the resource center and fulfilling 12 other provisions of this bill will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Office of Substance Abuse.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes those portions of the committee amendment that establish procedures for involuntary treatment for certain chemically dependent persons and emergency treatment orders. This amendment also replaces the fiscal note to reflect these changes.
