Resolve, to Provide Group Insurance Coverage to Maine's Foster Parents.



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Sec. 1. Group insurance authorized. Resolved: That the 2 Department of Human Services is authorized to provide group insurance coverage to the state's foster parents; and be it 4 further

6 Sec. 2. Plan established. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services shall establish a group health care insurance plan 8 for licensed foster parents. Participation in the plan is 9 optional for foster parents. Premiums paid by foster parents 10 must take into account the foster parents' income.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve requires the Department of Human Services to 16 provide assistance to foster parents who have no health insurance by offering them group health insurance coverage and developing a 18 cost sharing plan with the foster parents.

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
