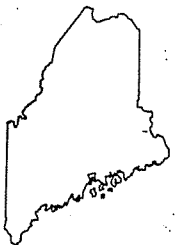

An Act to Authorize Flag Plates on Motor Vehicles.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRS §252-H is enacted to read:

§252-H. Flag plates

The Secretary of State, upon evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482 and payment of registration and licensing fees in accordance with section 242, shall authorize the use of a flag plate. The flag plate must be of a design depicting the United States flag approved by the Secretary of State. The flag plate may be displayed in place of the front registration plate on any motor vehicle registered in this State, except a truck tractor.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes the use of a flag plate in place of a regular front motor vehicle registration plate.
