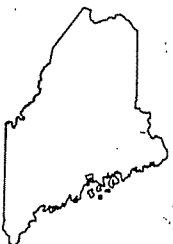
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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

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An Act Concerning Access to Tax Records.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §191, sub-§2, ¶K, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 769, Pt. A, §145, is amended to read:

K. The disclosure by a municipal assessor or the State Tax Assessor, or by the State Tax Assessor with regard to the unorganized territory, of information contained on the declaration of value form required by section 4641-B;

Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §4641-E, as amended by PL 1977, c. 679, §32, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The State Tax Assessor shall keep all records necessary to disclose information pursuant to section 191, subsection 2, paragraph K.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows disclosure by the State Tax Assessor, not simply municipal assessors, of information relating to all declarations of value, whether the subject property is in a municipality or the unorganized territory.
