STATEMENT OF FACT

24 The purpose of this bill is to provide case management and support services to the thousands of adolescents in the Greater 26 Portland who are experiencing one or more significant social problems, such as substance abuse, sexual abuse, homelessness and 28 mental illness. This bill provides a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Human Services to contract with Case 30 Management for Youth, Incorporated, which has been formed to implement a model case management system as recommended by the 32 Greater Portland Case Management Task Force. The funds will be used to provide case management services and for administrative 34 costs.
