**An Act to Appropriate Funds for Case Management Services for
Troubled Youth in the Greater Portland Area.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide case management and support services to the thousands of adolescents in the Greater Portland who are experiencing one or more significant social problems, such as substance abuse, sexual abuse, homelessness and mental illness. This bill provides a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Human Services to contract with Case Management for Youth, Incorporated, which has been formed to implement a model case management system as recommended by the Greater Portland Case Management Task Force. The funds will be used to provide case management services and for administrative costs.
