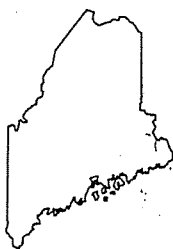

An Act to Limit the Number of Workers on Lobster Boats.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
3 12 MRSA §6421, sub-§3-A, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 455, §2,
4 is amended to read:

6 3-A. License limitation. A license shall--authorize
7 authorizes activities by individuals as follows.

8
9 A. A Class I license shall--only--authorize authorizes the
10 licensed activities by only the individual who is named in
11 the license. Any individual assisting or helping a Class I
12 license holder in these activities shall must also be
13 licensed.

14
15 B. A Class II license shall--authorize authorizes the
16 license holder to engage in the licensed activities. A
17 Class II license holder may engage a maximum of 2 unlicensed
18 crew members to assist in the licensed activities under the
19 direct supervision of the Class II license holder.

20
21 Notwithstanding paragraph B, the number of workers engaged in
22 licensed activities on a lobster boat is limited to 2, including
23 license holders.
