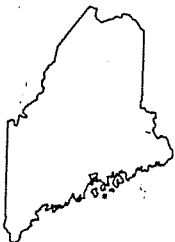

An Act to Amend the State Architect Licensure Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
32 MRSA §226, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 463, §3, is
4 amended to read:

6 2. Drawings and specifications; construction or
development. Nothing in this chapter shall may be construed to
8 prevent any person from making a set of drawings or
specifications for, or supervising the construction or
10 development of, or the occasional or incidental erection,
construction or development of:

12 A. Any building intended for occupancy by himself that
14 person or any person, association or corporation regularly
employing him that person;

16 B. Any building used for farm purposes;

18 C. Any single family residence ~~used by that person as his~~
20 ~~home~~ or any family residence up to and including 4-plex
units;

22 D. Any remodeling or alteration of existing buildings ~~not~~
24 ~~involving structural changes; provided such person shall not~~
~~receive any compensation for making such drawings and~~
26 ~~specifications~~; and

28 E. Any land or body of water which that is the primary or
30 temporary residence of that person or any person,
association or corporation regularly employing that person.

32 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

34 This bill amends the state architects licensure laws by
36 expanding the work that may be done without an architect license.
