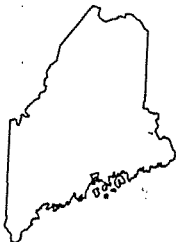

**An Act to Restrict the Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages in Licensed
Day Care Homes.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §8305, sub-§3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 358, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

3. Suspension or revocation of registration. A certificate of registration issued under this chapter may be suspended or revoked for:

A. A violation of applicable law;

B. Committing or permitting conduct or practices detrimental to the welfare of the children receiving home baby-sitting services; or

C. The consumption of any alcoholic beverage or substance containing alcohol or the use of any illegal drug by a person providing home baby-sitting services while a child or children are under that person's care.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill makes the consumption of alcoholic beverages or the use of illegal drugs by day care providers while they are caring for children grounds for suspension or revocation of their license.
