IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Decrease the Number of Years of Service Required for Receipt of Retirement Benefits.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

This bill changes the required number of years of service for a spouse to receive benefits to 20, but provides that an actuarial equivalent of 1/25 of the benefit due with 25 years of service would be deducted for each year of total service that is less than 25 years.
