COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 130, L.D. 232, Bill, "An Act Concerning Road Kills"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7503, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1991, c. 443, §27, is repealed.'

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7503, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Road kills. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Part or any rule adopted by the commissioner pursuant to this Part, it is lawful for any person at any time to pick up, possess, transport or otherwise make use of any wild animal or wild bird that has been killed as a result of a collision with a motor vehicle.

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7505, sub-§§1 and 2, as amended by PL 1979, c. 723, §24, are repealed.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Fisheries and Wildlife, strikes the language of the bill and replaces it with language that makes it lawful for any person at any time to pick up, possess, transport or otherwise make use of any wild animal or wild bird that has been killed as a result of a collision with a motor vehicle.
