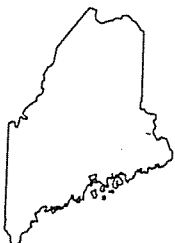

An Act Concerning Road Kills.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

25 MRSA §2913 is enacted to read:

§2913. Animals; road kills

The Department of Public Safety is required to clean up dead animals on the State's highways.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill makes it the responsibility of the Department of Public Safety to clean up dead animals on the highways.
