COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 131, L.D. 233, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Provisions Regarding the Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for the costs associated with printing the Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint forms.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill transfers the responsibility for the creation and issuance of Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint forms from the District Court to the Commissioner of Public Safety. This will reduce the cost to the General Fund in the amount of \$8,333 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$10,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 and transfer those costs of the Highway Fund.

The Department of Public Safety will absorb the administrative costs associated with the issuance of the forms within the additional allocations indicated and other budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds appropriation and allocation sections to shift the funds for producing the Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint funds from the District Court to the Department of Public Safety. It also adds a fiscal note.
