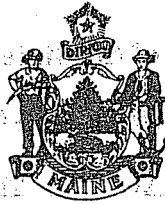

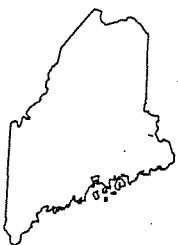

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Provisions Regarding the Uniform Traffic Ticket
and Complaint.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2300, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Creation of forms. The Commissioner of Public Safety is responsible for creating the forms of Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint, subject to the approval of the forms by the Chief Judge of the District Court.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §2300, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 430, §54, is amended to read:

A. ~~The District-Court~~ Commissioner of Public Safety shall be responsible for all Uniform Traffic Tickets and Complaints issued to law enforcement agencies or others.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill places the responsibility for the creation and issuance of forms of the Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint with the Commissioner of Public Safety. This bill also subjects the forms to the approval of the Chief Judge of the District Court.
