STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Expedite Erosion Control on the Shoreline of Sebago Lake in the Town of Standish.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

38 MRSA §480-C, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Exception. Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter, a person may place, construct or repair any riprap, retaining wall or erosion control device on lands adjacent to Sebago Lake within the Town of Standish by obtaining a permit from the Standish code enforcement officer authorizing such placement, construction or repair.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to expedite erosion control on the shoreline of Sebago Lake in the Town of Standish. This bill authorizes the placement, construction or repair of riprap, retaining walls or erosion control devices on land adjacent to Sebago Lake within the Town of Standish with a permit from the Standish code enforcement officer. Under current law, such placement, construction or repair requires a permit from the Department of Environmental Protection.
