An Act to Expedite Erosion Control on the Shoreline of Sebago Lake in
the Town of Standish.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

38 MRSA §480-C, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

5 4. Exception. Notwithstanding the provisions of this
6 chapter, a person may place, construct or repair any riprap,
7 retaining wall or erosion control device on lands adjacent to
8 Sebago Lake within the Town of Standish by obtaining a permit
9 from the Standish code enforcement officer authorizing such
10 placement, construction or repair.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of the bill is to expedite erosion control on
16 the shoreline of Sebago Lake in the Town of Standish. This bill
17 authorizes the placement, construction or repair of riprap,
18 retaining walls or erosion control devices on land adjacent to
19 Sebago Lake within the Town of Standish with a permit from the
20 Standish code enforcement officer. Under current law, such
21 placement, construction or repair requires a permit from the
22 Department of Environmental Protection.
