An Act to Prohibit Insurance Companies From Referring Clients Directly to Particular Glass Companies.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	24-A MRSA §2164-C, as reallocated by PL 1979, c. 663, §143,

8 10	No <u>An</u> insurer, domestic or foreign, or its agent or employee, shall may not require, directly or indirectly, that appraisals or repairs to motor vehicle glass should be or should
10	not be made in a specified place of business and the insurer may
12	not recommend or suggest a specified place of business.

18	This bill prohibits insurers and their agents and employees from recommending or suggesting specific auto glass companies for
