'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, addition of a student member to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System is a priority; and

28 Whereas, failure to enact this legislation as an emergency will deny student representation on the Board of Trustees of the 30 Maine Technical College System until at least February, 1992; and

32 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 34 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 36 safety; now, therefore,

38 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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 Membership. The board of trustees shall--consist consists of 9 10 appointed voting members and 2 3 ex officio, voting members as follows:

One from the State Board of Education; 2 One from the Board of Trustees of the University of в. 4 Maine System; 6 Seven from the field of business and industry, the field c. of labor, the field of education and the general public; 8 D. The Commissioner of Education, or the commissioner's 10 successor, who shall serve ex officio; The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development, 12 Ε. or the commissioner's successor, who shall serve ex officio; 14 and 16 F. The Commissioner of Labor, or the commissioner's successor, who shall serve ex officio-; and 18 G. One member who is from the student body of one of the 20 technical college campuses at the time of appointment and who is a permanent resident of the State. To be eligible 22 for appointment as a student member, a student must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester. 24 The student member is a full voting member of the board of trustees and shall serve for a 2-year term and until a 26 successor is qualified. By January 1st of every 2nd year, 28 the president of the system shall solicit a list of 5 eligible students from the student governments from 5 of the 30 campuses within the Maine Technical College System; the 6th campus being excluded in accordance with this subsection. The Governor shall then nominate a student trustee chosen 32 from the list within 30 days of receiving the list of names. The nomination is subject to review by the joint 34 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction 36 over education matters and to confirmation by the Legislature. The student trustee may not come from the same 38 campus in any 2 consecutive terms. In the event that the student trustee transfers from one campus to another during 40 the student's term of appointment, the student's original

Sec. 2. Transition. The following provision governs the transition to the appointment of a student member of the Board of
Trustees of the Maine Technical College System under this Act.

The amendment adds an emergency preamble, transition language and an emergency clause to permit immediate selection of the first student trustee. 26 2.
