COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 174, L.D. 259, "Resolve, to Create a Pilot Project for a Substance Abuse Halfway House for Pregnant Women and Mothers with Young Children"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Assure that an Appropriate Number of Child Care Vouchers are Allocated to the Children of Substance Abusers'

Further amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

'Child care vouchers for children of substance abusers. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services shall allocate an appropriate number of child care vouchers to children of parents who are in treatment for substance abuse.'

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will allocate and maintain an appropriate number of child care vouchers to children of parents who are in treatment for substance abuse within the funds budgeted and available for child care vouchers.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment replaces the original resolve. It directs the Department of Human Services to allocate an appropriate number of child care vouchers to children of parents who are in treatment for substance abuse.
