Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this legislation is necessary in order to clarify the responsibility for providing and paying for the security of the courts and the safety of the public with regard to prisoners; and

10 Whereas, Cumberland County has not entered into an agreement with the Judicial Department for court security services pursuant to Public Law 1989, chapter 722, section 1; and 12

Whereas, the Judicial Department must seek alternative means of providing court security for this county in a manner that satisfies the cost-containment provisions of Public Law 1989,16 chapter 722, section 1; and

Whereas, a transfer of court officers from county to state 20 employment provides the most effective means of controlling court security costs in Cumberland County; and

Whereas, a transfer of available funds and an increase in 24 the Judicial Department position count are necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act; and 26

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 28 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 30 safety; now, therefore,

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 security cost-containment As an extension of court legislation passed by the Second Regular Session of the 114th 10 Legislature, Public Law 1989, chapter 722, section 1, this bill gives the Judicial Department the authority to hire qualified personnel as state employees to perform court security functions 12 in Cumberland County. In order to accomplish this, this bill increases the Judicial Department position count by 6 and 14 provides for the transfer of funds from All Other to Personal Services with a cost savings to the General Fund. ·16
