An Act Regarding Traffic Violations Bureaus.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4 MRSA §164, sub-§12, as amended by PL 1989, c. 891, Pt. A, §7, is further amended by amending the 1st paragraph to read:

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~~Establish in each division~~
a one or more Traffic Violations Bureau Bureaus. The Chief Judge shall appoint ~~the clerks of the District Court in each division~~ as a violations clerk for the each Traffic Violations Bureau ~~in their respective divisions~~ established.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The bill eliminates the requirement that there be a Traffic Violations Bureau in each separate division within the District Court so as to allow the Chief Judge to establish one or more locations for the receipt of waivers.

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
