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Further amend the bill in that part designated "\$607." in 2 the first paragraph in the first to 3rd lines (page 2, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 4 "and each person who participates in roller skating must be aware of and accept those dangers' and inserting in its place the following: 'by 6 participating in roller skating a person accepts those dangers' 8 Further amend the bill in that part designated "S608." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 28 in L.D.) 10 by inserting after the underlined word "<u>liable</u>" the following: 'to an injured person' 12 14 Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following: 16 **'FISCAL NOTE** 18 20 The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of new cases filed in District Court as a result of the violation will be absorbed within the budgeted 22 resources of the Judicial Department.' 24 STATEMENT OF FACT 26 28 This amendment makes the following changes in the bill. 30 The amendment eliminates the definition of "spectator," 1. since that word is not used in the bill. 32 2. The bill requires that a roller-skating rink post the regulations, called duties, to which skaters must adhere. 34 The amendment adds the required posting of a statement that a skater 36 accepts the dangers inherent in skating. 38 з. In three places in the section describing skaters' duties the word "is" is used. This amendment substitutes the word "shall" in order to emphasize that the skater has a legal 40 requirement to fulfill these duties. 42 4. The bill has a statement regarding the dangers inherent in skating. The purpose of this section is, essentially, to recognize these dangers in Maine law to create a greater 44 46 certainty of how a judge will decide a liability suit brought against a rink operator. This amendment changes the wording of the first sentence of this section to make it better relate to 48 tort law. 50

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5. The amendment indicates that the only liability involved in a violation of this subchapter is that of the violator to an injured party, thereby clarifying that the provisions of the bill are not enforceable by the State and that there is no civil penalty.
