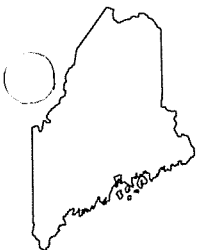

An Act Regarding the Collection of Fines.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

34-A MRSA §5404, sub-§5, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 459,
4 §6, is amended to read:

6 B. The officer shall pay the fines collected to the
