

SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 192, L.D. 274, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1991 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law"

Amend the amendment in section DD-5 in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 6, line 14 in amendment) by striking out the following: "a clothing" and inserting in its place the following: 'any' and in the 6th line (page 6, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "in the City of Biddeford" and inserting in its place the following: 'or company that is in danger of closure' and in the 8th line (page 6, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the following: "clothing" and in the next to the last line (page 6, line 18 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "manufacturing plant" the following: 'or company' and in the last line by striking out the following: "City of Biddeford" and inserting in its place the following: 'municipality'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires the Department of Economic and Community Development to work with and provides resources to any group conducting a preliminary assessment of the advisability of a comprehensive study that explores the feasibility of having a company or group purchase any manufacturing plant or company that is in danger of closure rather than just the clothing manufacturing plant in Biddeford.
