SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 192,
L.D. 274, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and
Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the
Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1991 and to Change Certain Provisions
of the Law"

Amend the amendment in that part designated PART GG in
Sec. GG-2. by inserting at the end (page 3, line 20 in amendment)
the following:

'This subsection may not be construed to limit or restrict any
right or remedy that a person or class of persons may otherwise
have under any statute or common law.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to preserve the rights and
remedies of persons under other statute or common law for harm
that might be caused as a result of municipal salt or sand-salt
storage activities.
