SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 192, L.D. 274, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1991 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law"

Amend the amendment in PART GG in section GG-1 in subsection 3 in the 3rd paragraph in the 3rd to 5th lines (page 1, lines 43 to 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "municipality's legislative body or in school units in which another body finally approves the school budget by action of that body." and inserting in its place the following: 'local school board'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows local school boards, rather than municipal legislative bodies or other bodies, to eliminate or defer a state mandate.
