SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 192, L.D. 274, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1991 and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law"

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part N and inserting in its place the following:

PART N

Sec. N-1. 22 MRSA §7202, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 536, §2, is amended to read:


The Division of Driver Education Evaluation is established within the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Health. The Division of Driver Education Evaluation shall administer the alcohol and other drug education, evaluation and treatment program. The division shall certify to the Secretary of State:

Sec. N-2. 22 MRSA c. 1602, sub-c. II-A is repealed.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes all of Part N of the bill that would have placed the driver education evaluation programs under the Department of Corrections. This amendment retains the programs under the jurisdiction of the Department of Human Services, but places it under the Bureau of Health. This amendment also repeals the Office of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention to conform with Part Y of the bill.
