26	'Sec. CC-3. Special task force. A special task force is created

	including, but not limited to, the maximization of federal funds.
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34	1. The task force includes the chair of the Maine Health Program Advisory Committee and 2 members of the Joint Standing

- 3. The task force shall make recommendations by May 1, 1991 to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs regarding the financing, federal funding and design of the Maine Health Program for the fiscal years 1991-92 and 1992-93.
- 4. The Department of Human Services and the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation shall provide to the task force consultation and information as requested.
- 5. The Office of Fiscal and Program Review shall provide 16 staff support as requested by the chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.'

Further amend the bill in Part CC by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment creates a special task force to evaluate utilization patterns of the adult population and to make recommendations on whether the benefit plan under the Maine Health Program should be redesigned. The amendment also changes the reporting date of the Maine Health Program Advisory Committee from April 15, 1991 to April 1, 1991.
