COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 186, L.D. 279, Bill, "An Act to Allow Minors to Make Anatomical Gifts"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2902, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 193, is amended to read:

1. **Individuals.** Any individual of sound mind and at least 16 years of legal age may give all or any part of his that individual's body for any purposes specified in section 2903, the gift to take effect upon death.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The costs associated with issuing additional decals and other administrative responsibilities will be absorbed by the Division of Motor Vehicles utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment enables people who are at least 16 years of age to make anatomical gifts without parental consent. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
